Traffic/Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

To ensure safety for our students and staff, we want to reinforce our drop-off and pick-up routines and rules done in coordination with the junior high. Please review this information carefully.

- Only buses, childcare vans and staff are permitted in the Lakeshire Drive entrance.
 Please note that this is one-way traffic only.
- The Astral Drive entrance is for parents using the Kiss and Go Loop.
- Please drive slowly in this area. Safety comes first. Maintain two lanes of traffic only. Parents may quickly unbuckle children. Do not park, wait, or leave your car in the loop as it stops traffic flow.
- Please drop children off by the curb in one of the designated drop-off spots only. Do
 not let your child in/out in the middle of the circle.
- If you're staying with your child on the playground, please park on the street. There is no parking permitted on the hill to keep traffic moving safely in both directions.
- The traffic circle will be closed during any early dismissal days.

Winter Concert Information

Important Notes for Families:

- Please do not arrive more than 5 minutes before your scheduled in-person appointment.
- To ensure the event runs smoothly, we kindly ask all families to adhere to the 10 minute time limit. If you require more time with a teacher, please arrange a separate meeting or phone call.
- If you would like to meet with more than one teacher (e.g., classroom, resource, ELST, or LC), please indicate this when booking.

Planning for Inclement Weather

HRCE takes great care when making the decision to alter the regular operations of schools and school buses in the event of severe or inclement weather.

It is HRCE's goal to communicate any changes to the regular operations of schools and/or buses as close to 6:00 a.m. as possible. A 6:00 a.m. announcement could be:

- All schools are delayed in opening by two hours
 - Our delayed start is 10:30am and bus pickups are delayed by two hours; or
- All schools are open, but some or all busses are not operating for the day; or
- Some schools (either individually or by family) are closed for the day; or
- All schools are closed for the day.

If weather deteriorates, or is forecasted to worsen throughout the morning, an 11:00 a.m. announcement could be:

- Bussed students are picked up two hours earlier than regular dismissal time at 12:25pm;
 and
- Walking students will be dismissed from their regular dismissal doors at 11:25am.

Early Dismissal - Parent Pick-Up Procedures

At 11:25AM Parents/guardians will report to a designated door to pick up their child, based on classroom location. Teachers will escort students to the door at **11:25am**.

- 1. Pre-Primary pick up (Astral Drive Side).
- 2. Main Entrance (Astral Drive Side)
- 3. Back Doors (Lakeshire Drive Side)
- 4. Modular Doors (Lakeshire Drive Side)

Traffic circle will be closed during any early dismissal days. Please Park on Astral Drive or Lakeshire Drive and walk to the doors to meet your child.

Friendly Reminders

- o All visitors must check in at the *main building office* and follow our safety procedures.
- O Video recordings are not permitted inside/near the school where children could be present.

Arrival Times

- 8:15 AM School doors open. Teachers inside and students go straight to classrooms.
- 8:30 AM Instruction starts. Students arriving after 8:30, check in at the office for late arrival
- Supervision Staff help guide arrival/dismissal (8:10am & 2:25pm). Do not send students before supervision.
